

## RULES & REGULATIONS DELAMONT CARAVAN PARK

### IN MAKING A BOOKING YOU ARE AGREEING THAT YOU AND YOUR PARTY WILL ADHERE TO THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS.

1. Admission to the Caravan Park to those under 18 will be refused unless accompanied by an adult for the full duration of the stay.
2. The Park Warden and staff have the right to refuse admission to the Caravan Park to anyone who has failed to adhere to these rules on a previous visit.
3. Check in is **from 2pm** and check out is **before 1pm sharp**.
4. Children must be under the supervision of their parents or guardians at all times.
- 5. Open fires and fire pits are strictly prohibited.**
6. A speed limit of **5 mph** must be observed at all times, and the one-way system must be followed.
7. In the event of a fire please proceed to the fire assembly point which is located beside the main gates.
8. No instrument or apparatus for amplifying sound shall be used on the site unless approved by the District Council.
9. **No noise permitted between 11pm and 7am.** This includes, but is not exclusive to, raised voices, musical instruments, radios, cd players, speakers or any other noisy equipment.
10. Each site must be kept free from litter.
11. Patrons on site must recycle their waste in the appropriate bins at the recycling area to the right of the reception building.
12. Riding of bicycles, skateboards, etc. is forbidden where it is deemed to be an annoyance to other visitors.
13. The erection of clothes lines is not permitted on site.
14. Ball games are not allowed around touring vehicles and tents or around buildings
15. The use of water balloons and playing of water games is not allowed
16. Generators used to produce electric are not allowed on site.
17. The use of drones, remote control aircraft, remote-control toy cars and electric scooters is not permitted.
18. Swings must not be erected on site or rope swings attached to trees.
19. Vehicles must not be driven on grassed areas of the campsite, except when accessing the grass area beside a pitch for car parking. This is to prevent damage to the grass and maintain the safety and appearance of the campsite.
20. Dogs and other pets must be always kept under control and on a lead. Anyone whose dog causes a nuisance to other users may be asked to remove the animal or leave the site. Any dog foul must be cleared immediately and binned.
21. Caravans and tents must not be left unoccupied for more than 24 hours without notifying the Warden.
22. Guests of site users are **not** permitted to bring vehicles into the campsite. They must use the car parking area to the left of the reception building, where spaces are limited. If no spaces are available, guests must use the main park car park, where parking charges will apply. Please note that this car park is locked in line with park opening hours.
